**15 - Day Camping Safari
Main to Victoriafalls**

The casual visitor to Botswana could be excused for seeing the country as kilometer upon kilometer of flat, desolate scrubland with little or no surface water. However, to the north lies the magnificent Okavango waterway, with its green and fertile plains, flowing straight into the sea of sand, the Kalahari Desert, and creating a unique natural wonderland – home to a multitude of Africa's Fauna and Flora. Almost a quarter of this country is devoted to wildlife sanctuaries and these remote and unspoilt wilderness areas are widely acknowledged as offering the finest game viewing in Africa.

DAY 1: ARRIVAL - MAUN LODGE ◉ B D

On arrival at the Maun Airport we are met by the Drifters staff and transferred to the Drifters Maun Lodge. The Lodge is located on the banks of the seasonal Boteti river and offer comfortable accommodation in tented units overlooking the river. This afternoon there will be time for a swim in the pool or just to relax and enjoy the serenity of the area. We enjoy a catered meal prepared by the Lodge.



DAY 2 - 4: CENTRAL KALAHARI DATE 3 x ◉ B L D

This morning, after a sumptuous breakfast at the Drifters Maun Lodge, we make our way towards the Central Kalahari Desert in Botswana and the second largest Game Reserve in the World. We will enjoy lunch on arrival in the Kalahari after which we will be doing some game driving. We will spend three nights in the Kalahari, mainly doing game drives.

Serviced Camping

The Private Botswana tour offers guests the added value of a serviced camping experience in the National Parks of Botswana. During our nights in the Parks the Drifters staff will handle the camp setup every night and our staff will put up your tent and take care of all the camp duties which mean there is no participation required from guests.



DAY 5: MAKGADIKGADI PANS

After breakfast, we venture eastward into the spectacular Makgadikgadi Salt Pans. Besides the stark scenery, the Pans are known for their prolific birdlife and the other desert adapted animals. Without disturbing the surface, we make our way to a remote site where we set up camp and take in the isolation and serenity of this expanse. Although we set up tents, we encourage clients to enjoy a night out under the canopy of stars.



DAY 6: MAUN LODGE ◉ B L D

After a relaxed morning we make our way out of the pans and back to the Drifters Maun Lodge. This afternoon there will be time for a swim in the pool or just to relax and enjoy the serenity of the area. We enjoy a catered meal prepared by the Lodge.



DAY 7 - 12: FLEXIBLE GAME RESERVE SCHEDULE (Moremi, Savuti & Chobe)

This morning we enjoy breakfast and then depart from the Lodge into the National Parks of Botswana. In our well-equipped 4 X 4 vehicle we head into the wilderness, passing remote villages along the way to the well know Moremi where we camp the next 6 nights around the marsh lands of the area. Moremi offers a multitude of game drive options and very active campsites (keep the fruit well hidden from the roving Elephant, and the meat from the prowling Hyenas).

We will spend most our time in the park in search of animals and our guide will take time to explain the behavior of the animals we encounter.



The vegetation is constantly changing, from open plains, palm trees and marshland, to dense Mopane woodlands and Acacia scrub as we travel through Moremi into Savuti and finally into the Chobe flats known for its great herds of elephants. Each night we will camp in pristine, remote, private sites where there is no sign of Mans existence – we leave each site in the same condition with the only thing taken are photos and the only thing left are footprints.



DAY 13 : CHOBE RIVER - VICTORIA FALLS

Our last morning in the Parks, we slowly game drive our way out towards the mighty Chobe River. The Chobe area is known for its huge herds of elephant and other animals that are attracted to drink from the river – this afternoon we will enjoy an extensive boat cruise, gliding close to the banks we hope to be able to approach these



animals from the river for a close up viewing. After the boat cruise, the guide will take the group to the border, from where they will be transferred to the Greenfire Victoria Falls Lodge (or similar) which is centrally located and within walking distance of the Falls and other attractions. Lunch today is own expense.

DAY 14: VICTORIA FALLS 2 x ◎ll B

Awaking in the adventure capital of Africa, it is with new excitement that we explore the amazing Victoria Falls, "Mosi o Tunya", "The smoke that thunders". After admiring this wonder of the world, various other attractions can be visited and activities enjoyed. – the tribal village, the big tree, ,k the curio market, and they crocodile farm. An aircraft flip over the falls, White water rafting or Bungee Jumping is all worthwhile, but allowance must be made for extra expense. We spend our last night here, thus allowing clients to explore by themselves.

DAY 15: DEPARTURE ◎ll B

After a sumptuous breakfast, we pack up and depart to the Victoria Falls Airport.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

Please note that Southern African weather conditions vary tremendously from season to season. During summer months temperatures of up to 40°C can be experienced. During the winter months of June, July and August the nights are very cold, temperatures may drop well below 0°C, although the day temperatures will be pleasant at around 20°C. Please take weather conditions into consideration when choosing a sleeping bag for your tour.

FOREIGN CURRENCY

Botswana Pula is the currency used in Botswana. Botswana Pula can be obtained at a main branch of any major bank in South Africa. If you cannot obtain Pula before your departure ex Johannesburg, please ensure that you have sufficient Rand to purchase refreshments en route. Money can be exchanged at the airport on arrival in Maun, where all major foreign currencies can be exchanged for Pula.

Please do not rely on credit cards, as most of the places we visit on this tour will not have the facilities to deal with them.

Drifters trucks have safe-keeping facilities for extra cash/flight tickets/ passports.

INSURANCE

It is compulsory that all passengers make arrangements for adequate travel insurance to financially safeguard against unforeseen circumstances. If you need further information please do not hesitate to contact us. HEALTH PRECAUTIONS & REQUIREMENTS

The only necessary prophylaxis for Southern Africa (Botswana and Zimbabwe) is against Malaria. Please consult with your general practitioner regarding this. Resistant strains of Malaria occur in both Botswana and Zimbabwe and adequate chemo-prophylaxis is essential. Prevention is better than cure; please use insect repellent on exposed areas after sunset.

All Drifters guides have first aid boxes for use in emergencies, however we recommend that you bring along your own basic supply of medication, headache tablets etc.

PERSONAL EXPENSES

A reasonable amount of personal spending money must be brought on our tours. This is to cover own expense meals, bottled water, soft drinks, alcohol, sundry goods purchased- such as film, suntan cream etc., curios, optional extra excursions, airport tax, transfers and tips. In South Africa it is common courtesy to tip casual help for services rendered. In the case of your guide, if you were happy with his or her services, an amount of R 50 per day per person would constitute a reasonable tip. By not tipping for services you are expressing displeasure.

ON SAFARI

All our tours require participation from all group members. This entails assisting with the food preparation, washing of dishes, keeping the truck clean and the setting up of camp.

Please keep in mind that flexibility and an open mind will greatly contribute to an enjoyable safari.
